**Modified Stableford scoring:**

- Since 2012, the Barracuda Championship has been played using Modified Stableford scoring system, allocating points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole, with the goal of achieving the highest overall number of points
- Modified Stableford scoring:
  - Double eagle: +8 points
  - Eagle: +5 points
  - Birdie: +2 points
  - Par: 0 points
  - Bogey: -1 point
  - Double bogey or worse: -3 points

**Ben Martin (1<sup>st</sup>/+16)**

- Fifth 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 0-for-4 converting to victory (most recent: 2023 Corales Puntacana Championship/finished T8)
- Recorded nine birdies (+2 points each) against two bogeys (-1 point each)
- In six prior starts at the Barracuda Championship, owns two top-10 finishes (T6/2011, T7/2016)
- Enters the week No. 172 in the FedExCup standings
- In 13 starts this season, has one top-25 finish (T9/Corales Puntacana Championship)
- Bidding for his second PGA TOUR victory in his 267<sup>th</sup> career start
- One PGA TOUR win: 2015 Shriners Children's Open

**Additional notes:**

- **Nick Watney** (T2/+14) is bidding for his fourth top-10 finish in 12 career starts in the Barracuda Championship (T10/2003, T5/2006, T8/2014); playing as a sponsor exemption this week, Watney has two made cuts in six starts this season (T34/Puerto Rico Open, T45/ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic)
- **David Lipsky** (T2/+14) is making his third start at the Barracuda Championship (T34/2023, MC/2024); T3 finish two weeks ago at the John Deere Classic is his best finish of the season and his second-best finish in 130 career starts on TOUR (2<sup>nd</sup>/2024 Procore Championship)
- Sacramento native **Cameron Champ** (T4/+13) sits inside the top 10 after 18 holes for the third consecutive week (T10/ISCO Championship/finished T14, T8/John Deere Classic/finished T27)
- **Rico Hoey** (T4/+13) is making his third consecutive start at the Barracuda Championship and seeking his second-consecutive top-10 finish in the event (T8/2024, T20/2023)
- DP World Tour member **Todd Clements** (T4/+13) was the only player with multiple eagles (Nos. 3 and 11) and claims his first top-10 position after any round on the PGA TOUR in his fifth start

- 2018 Barracuda Championship winner **Andrew Putnam** (T10/+12) is bidding for his third top-10 finish in his last five starts (RBC Canadian Open/T6, Rocket Classic/T8)
- In nine career starts in the Barracuda Championship, **Patrick Rodgers** (T19/+9) owns nine made cuts and three top-10 finishes, including one runner-up (T5/2024, P2/2023, 3<sup>rd</sup>/2015)
- Defending champion and two-time PGA TOUR winner **Nick Dunlap** (151st/-6) owns three top-25 finishes in 19 starts this season and entered the week No. 124 in the FedExCup standings
- In the Modified Stableford scoring format, Erik van Rooyen holds the tournament's 72-hole scoring record of +50 (2021) and S.Y. Noh recorded the best 18-hole score of +23 (R1/2023)
- No 18-hole leader/co-leader has won the Barracuda Championship in the Modified Stableford format (since 2012)
