**Weather:** Sunny. High of 83. WSW wind 8-14 mph, with gusts up to 20 mph.

**36-hole cut:** 66 professionals at +11 points or better from a field of 154 professionals and two amateurs.

**Modified Stableford scoring:**

- Since 2012, the Barracuda Championship has been played using Modified Stableford scoring system, allocating points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole, with the goal of achieving the highest overall number of points
- Modified Stableford scoring:
  - Double eagle: +8 points
  - Eagle: +5 points
  - Birdie: +2 points
  - Par: 0 points
  - Bogey: -1 point
  - Double bogey or worse: -3 points

**Rico Hoey (1<sup>st</sup>/+26)**

- Holds second 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2025 American Express/finished T58)
- Best finish in 51 starts on TOUR: P2/2024 ISCO Championship
- Seeks to become the 11<sup>th</sup> first-time winner on TOUR this season (most recent: William Mouw/ISCO Championship)
- Seeks to become the eighth player since 2012 to earn their first PGA TOUR title at the Barracuda Championship
- Making third start at the Barracuda Championship (T20/2023, T8/2024)
- Has one top-10 in 21 starts this season: T7/ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic
- Entered the week at No. 106 in the FedExCup standings
- Rancho Cucamonga, California native who plays from Manila, Philippines
- Owns one victory on PGA TOUR Canada (2017) and one victory on the Korn Ferry Tour (2023)

**Additional notes:**

- 2021 Barracuda Championship winner **Erik van Rooyen** (T2/+25) seeks to join J.J. Henry (2) and Vaughn Taylor (2) as multiple winners of the event and become the third South African winner on TOUR this season (Garrick Higgo/Corales Puntacana Championship, Aldrich Potgieter/Rocket Classic)
- **Max McGreevy** (T2/+25), who entered this week with three consecutive missed cuts on TOUR, records 16 points in the second round, his best in six career rounds at the Barracuda Championship (previous: +9/R1/2025)
- In his fourth career PGA TOUR start, DP World Tour member and Cannes, France native **Tom Vaillant** (4th/+23) seeks his first top-10 finish on TOUR (best: T37/2024 ISCO Championship)
- **Joel Dahmen** (T5/+22) is bidding for his third top-10 finish in his sixth appearance at the Barracuda Championship (T7/2021, T10/2023)

- **Ryan Gerard** (T5/+22), the highest-ranked player in the field at No. 42 in the FedExCup standings, seeks his second top-five finish at the Barracuda Championship (5<sup>th</sup>/2023)
- PGA TOUR rookie **Jackson Suber** (T5/+22) has two top-10s in 18 starts this season (T6/Sony Open in Hawaii, T6/Rocket Classic); seeks to become second consecutive player and fifth since 2012 to win the event in debut appearance (Nick Dunlap/2024, Erik van Rooyen/2021, Collin Morikawa/2019, Gary Woodland/2013)
- **Ben Kohles** withdrew after the first round and **Garrick Higgo** (hip) withdrew during the second round
