Max Greyserman (T1/-4)

- Opens with a 4-under 67, his fifth consecutive round in the 60s at the event
- Holds second 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 0-for-1 converting to victory (2024 Puerto Rico Open/T15)
- Making second start at the Baycurrent Classic after finishing runner-up in 2024
- Owns four runner-up finishes in 53 starts (others: 2024 3M Open, 2024 Wyndham Championship, 2025 Rocket Classic)
- Enters the week No. 58 in the FedExCup Fall Standings

Bud Cauley (T1/-4)

- Records a 4-under 67, his 51st career bogey-free round on TOUR and second this season (Valspar Championship/R4)
- Holds third 18-hole lead/co-lead; 0-for-2 converting to victory (2012 RSM Classic/T20, 2017 RBC Heritage/T9)
- Making his Baycurrent Classic debut
- Making first start since finishing No. 47 in the 2025 FedExCup Playoffs at the BMW Championship
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (5.894)
- Has four top-10 finishes in 20 starts this season (T6/THE PLAYERS Championship, T4/Valspar Championship, T5/Valero Texas Open, 3rd/Charles Schwab Challenge)

Brian Campbell (T1/-4)

- Opens with a 4-under 67, including an eagle (No. 8) and a birdie on his final two holes
- Holds his first 18-hole lead/co-lead; previous-best first-round position: T2/2017 Truist Championship
- Making his Baycurrent Classic debut
- Two-time PGA TOUR winner this season (Mexico Open at VidantaWorld, John Deere Classic)
- One of 11 players in the field that have won on TOUR this season and one of six multiple winners on TOUR this season
- Finished No. 46 in the 2025 FedExCup Playoffs at the BMW Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- The 2025 Baycurrent Classic marks the first year with Baycurrent as title sponsor and Yokohama Country Club playing host to the event for the first time
- Three 18-hole co-leaders marks the most first-round co-leaders at the Baycurrent Classic (previous: 2/2019/Tiger Woods, Gary Woodland)
- 14-time PGA TOUR winner **Adam Scott** is making his third start at the Baycurrent Classic and 425th career start on TOUR; is one of two players in the field this week with over 400 TOUR starts (Camilo Villegas/437)
 - Enters the week No. 97 in the FedExCup Fall Standings and seeks his first top-10 result this season (best in 18 starts this season: T12/U.S. Open)
- Additional notable opening-round scores:

- Defending champion **Nico Echavarria** (T19/-1)
- 2023 Baycurrent Classic winner **Collin Morikawa** (T25/E)
- Highest-ranked player in the field at No. 4 in the Official World Golf Ranking **Xander Schauffele** (T25/E)
- Ehime, Japan native and 2021 Baycurrent Classic winner **Hideki Matsuyama** (T34/+1)

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The 2025 Baycurrent Classic is the third of the FedExCup Fall, a group of seven tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season
- Winners of events during the FedExCup Fall receive the similar benefits of winners of Full-Field Events during the Regular Season, including 500 FedExCup points, Official World Golf Ranking points, a two-year PGA TOUR exemption (exempt thru 2026) and invitations to The Sentry, THE PLAYERS Championship and PGA Championship
- The Aon Next 10 is an eligibility pathway that awards access into Signature Events (outside of The Sentry), recognizing the top 10 players, not otherwise exempt, from the FedExCup standings; Nos. 51-60 in the final FedExCup Fall standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will serve as the Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
