#### COMPLETED First-Round Notes – Friday, August 15, 2025

**Weather: Thursday:** Partly cloudy with afternoon thunderstorms. High of 88. Wind NNW 5-10 mph. The first round was suspended due to a dangerous weather situation at 2:35 p.m. ET and resumed at 4:48 p.m. (delay of 2 hours, 13 minutes). Play was suspended due to darkness at 8:12 p.m., with Bud Cauley the only player left to complete the round. **Friday:** Cauley's round resumed at 10:50 a.m. and concluded at 10:53 a.m., with his second-round tee time at 11:27 a.m. The second round began as scheduled at 9:21 a.m. Partly cloudy. High of 83. Wind ENE 5-10 mph.

## Robert MacIntyre (1st/-8)

- Equals his career-best score on TOUR with a 62 (2024 Travelers Championship/R2), including a career-high 10 birdies and personal-best nine-hole score of 29
- Career-high six birdies in a row on Nos. 13-18; previous-best streak was four in a row (2025 Travelers Championship/R2)
- Personal-best 195' 2" of putts made; previous-best was 166' 9" at the 2024 RBC Canadian Open/R3
- Marks his second 18-hole lead/co-lead in stroke-play events on TOUR (2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic/T13)
- Seeking his third PGA TOUR win in his 76<sup>th</sup> start (2024 RBC Canadian Open, 2024 Genesis Scottish Open)
- Enters the week No. 20 in the FedExCup standings; projected No. 4 with a win
- Has five top-10 finishes in 21 starts this season, led by a runner-up finish at the U.S. Open
- Making his second start at the BMW Championship (2024/WD/back injury)

#### **Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Tommy Fleetwood** (2<sup>nd</sup>/-5) turns in one of two bogey-free rounds (**Hideki Matsuyama**/69); last week's T3 at the FedEx St. Jude Championship marked the 43<sup>rd</sup> top-10 finish of his TOUR career, most of any player without a win on TOUR since 1983
