FEDEXCUP PLAYOFFS NOTES

The 2025 TOUR Championship format will be a 72-hole stroke play competition. The player with the lowest score after four rounds is named the winner of the FedExCup and awarded an official PGA TOUR victory.

The FedExCup Champion earns a five-season exemption.

The winner of the TOUR Championship, who is also the FedExCup Champion, earns \$10 million as the winner's share of the purse (\$40 million). This is Official Money and will count on the Official PGA TOUR Money List.

Any professional that is qualified for the TOUR Championship, but unable to participate and/or any professional who is disqualified or withdraws for any reason will finish in last position for the TOUR Championship. If multiple players do not play, they will tie for last place. Ties are determined the same way as Regular Season events when total money for each tying position is averaged which is then distributed to each player in tying position.

FEDEXCUP FALL NOTES

Players finishing top 50 will hold their position on the FedExCup Fall Points List. In the Fall, any points earned by top 50 players will not accumulate on the FedExCup Points List.

All players are playing for winners exemptions and Official World Golf Ranking points. Those outside the top 50 are playing for access to AT&T Pebble Beach and The Genesis Invitational, while those outside the top 70 are also playing for status for the following season.
