**Today** — Mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies this morning with temperatures climbing into the 80s. There will be a risk for showers/T-storms once again this afternoon, however activity should remain isolated to widely scattered in nature. The highest chances (20-30%) for impacts to Cave Valley would be between 2-6pm. An easterly wind is expected much of the day with a few gusts possibly reaching 15 mph this afternoon. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10" with localized amounts over 0.25" possible in a T-storm. **Sunrise: 6:18am / Sunset: 8:04pm**

**Extended forecast** – Dry conditions will be seen tonight, however areas of low overcast and fog likely develop. A slight reduction in moisture is expected on Saturday, finally leading to a day featuring no shower/T-storm development in the general area. For Sunday, a weak front may approach the area during the day. Only a slight chance (20%) for an afternoon T-storm will be mentioned in the forecast unless model guidance begins to highlight a stronger signal for precipitation.
