Rafael Campos
Butterfield Bermuda Championship

Rafael Campos earned his 1st PGA TOUR win in his 80th career start, becoming the first player from Puerto Rico to win on the PGA TOUR.

80th Rafael Campos won on his 80th career start at the age of 36 years, 7 months and 2 days, becoming the 14th and last player to win on their 80th start on the PGA TOUR All-Time

T40 After Campos shot 1-under and was T40 thru 18 holes, he went on to have 20 birdies or better going 18-under par for the rest of the week. He is one of the last five PGA TOUR winners to be 40th or worse after the first round and win.

62 Campos shot a 62 in the third round, marking his lowest round and tying his most birdies in a round (9: 2017 Puerto Rico Open RD 1) in his PGA TOUR career.

Campos found his rhythm on holes 7-12 going 13-under in that six hole stretch with a birdie or better 50.00% of the time. Campos hit 8.89% less fairways in this six hole stretch than the rest of the course but found the green 66.67% of the time. When Campos was in trouble he was able to get up and down going 8 for 8 scrambling on holes 7-12 compared to only successfully scrambling 75% of the time on the rest of the course.

FedExCup Fall Storylines

The 2025 Butterfield Bermuda Championship is the sixth event of the FedExCup Fall, a group of seven tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season.

The top 50 players in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions while No. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points over.

Aon Next 10 (players 51-60) through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2025: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational.

Winners of events during the FedExCup Fall receive a two-year PGA TOUR exemption, OWGR points and spots in THE PLAYERS Championship, RBC Heritage and PGA Championship in 2026

What's at Stake in the FedExCup Fall:

- **Aon Next 10:** Players in the Aon Next 10 through the RSM Classic will be eligible for the two west coast Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational)
- **The Top 100:** Will be fully-exempt for the 2026 PGA TOUR season
- **101-150:** Earn conditional status on PGA TOUR next season

- 50%** In each of the last two season 10 of the 20 players to finish inside in Aon Next 10 qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs the following season
- 25%** In each of the last two seasons, five of the 20 players to finish inside in Aon Next 10 finished inside the top 50 of the FedExCup Standings the following season and five of players qualified for the TOUR Championship the following season
- 75%** With four weeks left in the FedExCup Fall season, historically 75% of the players in the Aon Next 10 at this point finish the fall season in the final Aon Next 10, increasing by 15% from three weeks prior when the percentage was 60%.

- +132** Matt Kuchar is tied for the second highest Birdie Average Improvement on the PGA TOUR from Last Season to This Season (+132). Kuchar has improved in these four putting statistics from Last Season to This Season (*SG, One-Putt PCT, Putts Made Distance & Putting from Inside 10'*)
- 7** Nico Echavarria is tied for third in longest active rounds in the 60's Streak on the PGA TOUR This Season. Echavarria leads the FedExCup Fall in Par 3 Scoring (-31) since 2024. He has made 83.25% of cuts in International events compared to 42.03% in events in the United States.
- +157** Sami Valimaki has improved the most of any player in Putting Inside 10' from Last Season (159th) to This Season (2nd). Valimaki ties for second in longest active streak without a bogey or worse on the PGA TOUR This Season (33).

- +12** Carson Young improved 12 positions in FedExCup Fall Standings after World Wide Technology Championship, his best improvement in the FedExCup Fall This Season. Young improved in these three putting statistics from Last Season to This Season (*Putting from Inside 5', Putting from 3-5' & Putting Inside 10'*)
- 33.79** Matti Schmid is fourth in Going for Green - Hit Green Percentage on the PGA TOUR This Season. Schmid has improved in all Par 3 Categories from Last Season to This Season (*Performance, Scoring AVG & Birdie or Better PCT*). He has improved in each of the last two consecutive seasons in Strokes Gained: Putting.
- 35th** Chad Ramey has improved in each of the last two consecutive seasons in Sand Save Percentage, currently ranked 35th. Ramey improved 34 positions in the 2025 FedExCup Fall Standings after the World Wide Technology Championship (finished T2), he currently ranks 89th entering this week.

Michael Brennan, Rafael Campos, Sahith Theegala

- 87.50** Michael Brennan has a Driving Accuracy of 87.50%, the highest of any player in the 2025 FedExCup Fall season. Brennan also leads the PGA TOUR in average Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (+1.90) in the Fall. Brennan became a first time PGA TOUR winner in 2025, the third first time winner this season who was under the age of 24 when securing their win.
- 58.82** Rafael Campos is looking to become the first back-to-back winner of this event, securing his first career PGA TOUR win here in 2024. Campos's win made him the fourth International winner of this event. Campos has a Made Cut Percentage of 58.82% when playing international events, 29.87% higher than when playing events in the United States.
- 7.68** Sahith Theegala has a Made Putt PCT > 25' of 7.68% tied for the fourth highest of any player since 2024. Theegala has 81 Total Hole Outs since 2022, the third most of any player on the PGA TOUR in that span.

- 86** Going back to last season, Rico Hoey is 86-under par on Par 5's in FedEx Cup Fall events, the best of any player. Hoey has improved his approach game moving up 75 positions in Strokes Gained from Last Season. Hoey and Scottie Scheffler are the only two players ranked inside the Top 10 in both SG: Off-the-Tee and SG: Approach-the-Green.
- 10** Victor Perez ranks inside the Top 10 in Greens in Regulation from locations Other than the Fairway and in Proximity to the Hole from the Rough (left and right). He and Nick Hardy are the only two players to rank in the Top 10 across all four of these categories. Perez has also performed better in international events than in the United States, making over 20% more cuts, recording three additional Top 10 finishes, and two more Top 5 finishes.
- 12.46** Danny Walker has made 12.46% of putts from beyond 20 feet this season, putting him on pace for the fifth-highest make percentage in a single season on the PGA TOUR since 2004. He is also averaging 82' 5" of Putts Made Per Round, the second-highest of any player on TOUR this season.
