Today – Clouds are set to decrease early this morning becoming sunny to mostly sunny and dry for the remainder of the day. South-southeasterly winds will become breezy in the afternoon, becoming sustained at 10-16 mph along with gusts in the 20-25 mph range. The temperature is forecast to reach a high near 92°F, while the heat index will peak in the middle to upper 90s.

Extended forecast — Dry conditions are anticipated on Saturday, with breezy to windy conditions forecast throughout the day with south to south-southeasterly winds sustained at 10-20 mph and gusting between 20-30 mph. Some showers and thunderstorms may become possible Sunday afternoon ahead of a cold front set to sweep through Sunday night. Breezy south to south-southeasterly winds will continue Sunday. Widespread rain and thunderstorms will occur overnight Sunday into early Monday. There may be a break in rain and storm activity for a portion of Monday morning before thunderstorms become numerous once more for the afternoon and evening hours. Heat indices will top out in the middle to upper 90s this weekend.
