Today – Increasing moisture and a weak disturbance aloft is expected to set off clusters of rain and thunderstorms to our north along the TX/OK state line after 2pm. These thunderstorm complexes will sink to the south, with the greatest threat across the Metroplex expected to occur between 5-10pm. Breezy conditions are expected to arrive out ahead of these storms late in the afternoon, with gusts around 20 mph. Activity should diminish in coverage and intensity after 10pm with dry conditions likely by 2am Saturday. Strong to severe storms are possible this afternoon and evening, with threats of large hail and thunderstorm wind gusts between 55-65 mph. **Forecast rainfall through 8pm: 0.25" – 0.50"**

Extended forecast – Friday and Saturday should largely be dry, although an isolated coverage of thunderstorms may pop up in the afternoon and evening. A scattered coverage of showers and thunderstorms are expected Sunday afternoon ahead of a cold front set to sweep through Sunday night or early Monday. Breezy to windy conditions are forecast Friday through Sunday, with south to southeasterly wind gusts in the 20-30 mph range. Heat indices will top out in the low to mid 90s Friday through Sunday.
