**Today** – Sunny skies and dry conditions are forecast throughout the day. Temperatures will be in the upper 60s to low 70s this morning prior to reaching a high in the low 80s this afternoon. Northwestern winds will become breezy this morning and into the afternoon, becoming sustained at 10-17 mph along with gusts of 20-25 mph. Dry conditions will continue tonight with temperatures dipping into the low 60s.

**Extended forecast** – Dry conditions will continue Wednesday under sunny to partly cloudy skies. A weak disturbance may allow for a scattered coverage of showers and thunderstorms Thursday afternoon into Thursday night. Friday and Saturday should largely be dry, although an isolated coverage of showers or thunderstorms may pop up in the afternoon and evening. Another weak disturbance could return a scattered coverage of showers and thunderstorms on Sunday afternoon. Breezy to windy conditions are forecast Friday through Sunday, with southerly wind gusts in the 20-30 mph range.
