**Today** – Light and brief passing showers/sprinkles are possible through the early AM hours across the course. Conditions will slowly clear through mid-day as the sea breeze works inland, but additional marine-based showers may continue to feed in from the NE beyond 2-3PM. NE winds will rise through the day, peaking later this afternoon between 10-16mph. Gusts upwards of 23-25mph are expected.

**Extended forecast** – Increasing NE winds are expected Saturday through the weekend as the gradient tightens allowing winds to race through the Mona Passage. Gusts Saturday and Sunday will approach the upper-20s with a few near 30mph along the exposed parts of the course. Light marine showers do remain possible Saturday and Sunday, but coverage will be brief and favor the morning timeframe each day. Winds continue to rise into Monday with gusts exceeding 30mph during the afternoon.
