Ludvig Åberg (1st/-9)

- 9-under 63 at Torrey Pines North Course marks his low opening round on TOUR; previous low: 64/R1/2024 Genesis Scottish Open
- Holds the 18-hole lead/co-lead for the first time on TOUR
- Second start at the Farmers Insurance Open; only other appearance T9/2024
- Marks his second start of the 2025 season; finished T5 at The Sentry
- Won the 2023 RSM Classic, becoming the first PGA TOUR University alum to win on the PGA TOUR
- Second full season on TOUR; became the first player to join the TOUR via the No. 1 position in the 2023 PGA TOUR University Ranking

Additional player notes

- PGA TOUR rookie **Danny Walker** posts a career-low, bogey-free 7-under 65 and sits T2, marking the low round of the day on the South Course; seeks to make the cut for the first time in his fourth career start on TOUR; hit every green in regulation in the first round, becoming the 12th player to hit all 18 greens on the South course since 1980, and the first since Martin Laird in 2019 (R3)
- Making his first start of the season, **Hayden Springer** (T2/-7) opens in eagle-birdie fashion on Nos. 10-11 on the North Course; sits inside the top five of the leaderboard after the first round for the fifth time in his career (31st start)
- PGA TOUR winner **Lanto Griffin** (T4/-6), who earned low-medalist honors at the 2024 Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry; making his seventh appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open (best: T7/2021)
- **Zach Johnson** (T4/-6) makes his fifth start at the Farmers Insurance Open and first since 2007 (best: T24/2005)
- In his first season on TOUR, **Aldrich Potgieter** (T4/-6) records his career-low on TOUR in individual stroke-play event (previous: 69/2025 The American Express); is one of five 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduates at T10 or better
- The No. 1 finisher in the inaugural Class of 2021 PGA TOUR University Ranking and 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduate, **John Pak** (T8/-5), establishes his best career 18-hole position in an individual stroke-play event; sat T7 after the first round of the 2021 Barracuda Championship (Stableford scoring)
- **Hideki Matsuyama**, the highest-ranked player in the field at No. 4 in the Official World Golf Ranking, posts 4-under 68 on the South Course and sits T18
- Amateur **Jackson Koivun** cards a bogey-free 4-under 68 on the South Course and sits T18 in his first start of the 2025 season; leads **Luke Clanton** (T49/-2/NC) as the only two amateurs in the field

- Defending champion **Matthieu Pavon** posts 1-over 73 at the South Course and sits T100
- Braden Thornberry withdrew with illness during the first round
