COMPLETED Second-Round Notes - Friday, January 24, 2025

Thursday weather: Mostly sunny. High of 77. Wind ENE 8-14 mph with gusts exceeding 30 mph.

Friday weather: Mostly sunny. High of 67. Wind WNW 6-12 mph, gusting to 15 mph.

Suspension summary: Play was suspended due to strong winds at 2:05 p.m. PT Thursday. The second round resumed at 3:31 p.m. (delay of 1 hour, 26 minutes) and was suspended again due to darkness at 5:15 p.m. with 29 players yet to complete the round. The second round resumed at 7:31 a.m. Friday and completed at 8:38 a.m. Third-round tee times are scheduled for 9:30-11:30 a.m. off Nos. 1 and 10 tees on the South Course in groups of three.

CUT: 68 professionals and two amateurs at 1-over 145 from a field of 153 professionals and two amateurs.

Lanto Griffin (T1/-6)

- Holds his second career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2023 Shriners Children's Open/finished T13)
- Making his seventh appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open; in his six previous starts at the event, has logged five made cuts and one top-10 finish (T7/2021)
- Made two cuts in three starts this season, including this week (The American Express/T34)
- PGA TOUR wins (1): 2019 Texas Children's Houston Open
- Finished No. 158 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings after logging one top 10 in 22 starts; improved his status for the 2025 season by winning at Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry

Ludvig Åberg (T1/-6)

- 18-hole leader posts 3-over 75 after entering the day with his first career 18-hole lead/co-lead; only once since 1988 has the 18-hole leader/co-leader gone on to win the farmers Insurance Open (Patrick Reed/2021)
- Holds the 36-hole lead/co-lead for the fifth time on TOUR (2024 Genesis Scottish Open/T4; 2024 U.S. Open/T12; 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am/2nd; 2023 RSM Classic/Won)
- Making his second appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open (T9/2024)
- Marks his second start of the 2025 season (The Sentry/T5)
- PGA TOUR wins (1): 2023 RSM Classic

Additional player notes

- PGA TOUR rookie **Danny Walker** (3rd/-5) leads all players with 12 birdies en route to notching his first made cut on TOUR in his fourth career start
- In his first start of the season, **Hayden Springer** (T4/-4), who is playing out of the 126-150 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings, follows a first-round 65 with a 3-over 75 on the South Course via four bogeys against one birdie

- Sungjae Im (T4/-4) birdied three of his final five holes in the second round on the North Course (Nos. 5, 7, 9) to climb inside the top five on the leaderboard; makes seventh appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open, highlighted by two top-10 finishes (2023/T4, 2022/T6) in six prior starts
- Chris Gotterup (T4/-4), Jackson Suber (T13/-2) and Jason Day (T25/-1) share the low 18-hole score in round two with 3-under 69s; Gotterup and Day played the North Course, while Suber played the South Course
- Both amateurs in the field, **Luke Clanton** (T13/-2) and **Jackson Koivun** (T40/E), made the cut, marking the first time in the last 55 years that two amateurs have made the cut at the Farmers Insurance Open in a single year; last amateur to make the cut at this event: **Anthony Paolucci** (2011)
- Sahith Theegala (T40/E) made four putts of 20+ feet on the South Course (Nos. 3, 4, 14, 17); third player, along with Matthieu Pavon (2024/R2/5 putts) and Freddie Jacobson (2010/R1/4 putts), during the ShotLink era to make at least four putts over 20 feet in a round on the South Course
- Defending champion Matthieu Pavon (MC/+9) posts 8-over 80 on the North Course
- 75.203 marks the second-highest single round average on the North Course (previous: 77.39/R1/1993)
- Players who withdrew during the second round: Nate Lashley (illness), Hayden Buckley (illness), Max Homa (illness), Philip Knowles, David Lipsky, Max McGreevy, Paul Peterson, Kevin Roy, Emiliano Grillo
