**Harris English (1<sup>st</sup>/-9)**

- Seeks his fifth PGA TOUR victory in his 340<sup>th</sup> start; most recent win: 2021 Travelers Championship in an eight-hole playoff over Kramer Hickok
- Holds the 54-hole lead/co-lead for the fourth time on TOUR (1-for-3 to date: 2021 Sentry)
- Was a part of the four-man playoff won by Jason Day at the 2015 Farmers Insurance Open after holding his first 54-hole lead/co-lead one day earlier
- Span of 1,266 days since his last 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2021 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational/4<sup>th</sup>)
- Finished No. 55 in the FedExCup Fall standings in 2024 to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in his first 13 seasons on TOUR

**Additional player notes**

- **Andrew Novak** (2<sup>nd</sup>/-8) seeks his first PGA TOUR title in his 89<sup>th</sup> start; best finish on TOUR is runner-up at the 2024 Butterfield Bermuda Championship; making fourth appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open (T70/2022, T69/2023, MC/2024); bogey-free 66 marks second score in the 60s at Torrey Pines in 13 rounds (66/R1/2023); one of two players bogey-free on Friday (Danny Willett/70)
- South African 20-year-old PGA TOUR rookie **Aldrich Potgieter** (3<sup>rd</sup>/-7), the youngest TOUR member in the 2025 season, would become the youngest winner of the Farmers Insurance Open; makes four 2s in a single round, including an eagle at the par-4 12<sup>th</sup> hole when he holed out from 173 yards with a 8-iron; last player to make four 2s in a single round on the South Course: Emiliano Grillo/R1/2023; with a win on Saturday, would become the fourth international winner in the fourth event of the season (Hideki Matsuyama/Japan, Nick Taylor/Canada, Sepp Straka/Austria); last time four international players won the first four events of the season: 2003
- **K.H. Lee** (T4/-5) entered this week with two missed cuts in two starts in 2025; had not made the cut in four prior starts at the Farmers Insurance Open
- **Matti Schmid** (T4/-5) looks to improve on his best TOUR result in his 67<sup>th</sup> start (3<sup>rd</sup>/2023 Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- 2021 Corales Puntacana Championship winner **Joel Dahmen** (T4/-5) owns four missed cuts in six prior starts at this event (T9/2019, T55/2020)
- **Brandt Snedeker** (T8/-4) counts two wins (2012, 2016) among six top-3 results in 17 prior starts at the Farmers Insurance Open; most recent of nine PGA TOUR wins: 2018 Wyndham Championship
- Final grouping of **Lanto Griffin** (T4/-5), **Ludvig Åberg** (T8/-4) and **Danny Walker** (T51/+1) were a combined 9-over for the day
