Rory McIlroy (T1/-11)

- 2023 Genesis Scottish Open champion shares the lead with Chris Gotterup following a 4-under 66
- Would become the first player to win the Masters Tournament and Genesis Scottish Open in the same season
- In search of his 30th win on TOUR, which would move him to T16 (with Horton Smith) on the all-time wins list
- Would mark his fourth win of the season, equaling his most in a season on TOUR (2011-12 season)
- 21st 54-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke play events on TOUR (12-for-20 to date): most recent, 2025 Masters Tournament/won

Chris Gotterup (T1/-11)

- One day after tying the course record with a 61, carded an even-par 70 and is tied with Rory McIlroy
- Holds the third-round lead/co-lead for the second time (2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic/won); entered the final round in Myrtle Beach with a four-stroke lead before winning by six strokes after a final-round 67
- Has one victory in 61 PGA TOUR starts (2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic)
- Victory in Myrtle Beach marks his only top-10 finish in his last 56 starts on TOUR

Additional Player Notes

- Three-time PGA TOUR winner **Wyndham Clark** (T3/-9) is in search of his first win since the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am; has finished inside the top 25 in all three prior Genesis Scottish Open starts (T16/2022, T25/2023, T10/2024)
- Jake Knapp (T3/-9) trails by two in search of his second win in his 47th start (2024 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld)
- Marco Penge (T3/-9) is seeking his second win on the DP World Tour this season (Hainan Classic)
- Matt Fitzpatrick (T3/-9) is in search of his third PGA TOUR victory (2022 U.S. Open, 2023 RBC Heritage)
- World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler (T15/-6) trails by five following a third-round 69
- Romain Langasque (T20/-5) aces the par-3 14th hole with a pitching wedge from 147 yards; it is the second ace on No. 14 since 2022 (Nicolas Colsaerts/R2/2023)
- Paul Waring WD during the round with a shoulder injury
