



Scottish Open Forecast

7 AM Update

Saturday, 12 July 2025

Synopsis -

Areas of fog over Fife this morning may drift across the Firth early this morning but otherwise expect mostly sunny skies with winds increasing from the east-northeast this afternoon. Clouds will return later this afternoon and after 8pm this evening areas of fog will begin to move in off the North Sea. Fog will remain over the area overnight and through 10am tomorrow morning. By midday expect partial sunshine with much cooler temperatures and winds out of the east-northeast. Areas of fog will begin to return after 7pm and linger into the evening. Monday any fog will dissipate but a trough of low pressure will bring showers for the afternoon. Some of those showers may become heavy at times.
