Extended forecast – Dry conditions to continue through Saturday although cloud cover will increase as moisture lifts from the south. This moisture could eventually lead to a period of showers Saturday night/Sunday morning. The forecast has increased rain chances, but it appears the most organized rain/lightning activity remains southeast of Naples. A low (20%) threat for a shower will linger into Sunday afternoon as development may take place along the sea breeze. Otherwise, winds will increase out of the northwest with gusts of 15-20 mph possible.
