Chan Kim (1st/-9)

- 9-under 61 is one stroke shy of the tournament 18-hole record; marks his career-low round on TOUR; previous low was 63 (twice), most recently in the final round of the 2024 ISCO Championship; matches Pierceson Coody (2024) with the low first-round score in tournament history
- Bogey-free 61 included eagle-2 at No. 4 when he holed his approach shot from 123 yards
- Holds lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR for the first time after any round
- Four-stroke lead equals the largest first-round lead on TOUR this season (Jake Knapp/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches); largest 18-hole lead in ISCO Championship history
- Eight-time Japan Golf Tour winner and two-time Korn Ferry Tour winner seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 70th start; T5 at 2025 Valero Texas Open marks his best finish on TOUR
- Posted two top-10 results this season, in back-to-back starts (T5/Valero Texas Open, T7/Corales Puntacana Championship)
- Entering this week, has made one cut in his last seven starts on TOUR (T19/Rocket Classic)
- Making second appearance at ISCO Championship (T10/2024)

Additional notes

- Englishman and two-time DP World Tour winner **Callum Shinkwin's** (T2/-5) bogey-free 65 includes a 107-yard hole-out for an eagle-2 at No. 12
- PGA TOUR rookie Thomas Rosenmueller (T2/-5) matches his low round on TOUR (2024 Puerto Rico Open/R2)
- With a season-best finish of T41 at the Rocket Classic two weeks ago, **Peter Malnati** (T2/-5) enters the week at No. 190 in the FedExCup standings after being fully exempt on TOUR the last four seasons; owns two top-25s in six previous starts at the ISCO Championship (T18/2017, T21/2018)
- Kentucky native **Josh Teater** (T21/-2) notches an under-par opening-round score for the eighth consecutive time in eight starts at his home-state event
- Two amateurs in the field this week: 16-year-old **Miles Russell** (T53/E) and Auburn University sophomore **Jackson Koivun** (T105/+3)
- Five players who attended St. Xavier High School in Louisville, Kentucky are in the field this week: Stephen Stallings, Jr. (T53/E), Drew Doyle (T91/+2), Brendon Doyle (T105/+3), Cooper Musselman (T121/+4), Daniel Iceman (T150/+8)
- Anders Albertson withdrew before the first round and was replaced in the field by William McGirt (T121/+4)
