Extended forecast – Thunderstorm chances will increase Saturday afternoon ahead of a cold front across the Midwest. It will remain hot with highs reaching 92F/33C. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will become more likely Sunday as the cold front moves closer to Kentucky. Severe thunderstorms are not expected but storms will be capable of producing heavy rainfall and gusty winds. The front is forecast to move just south of Louisville decreasing the chances for thunderstorms.
