**Today** – An outflow boundary from storms in IL/MO is producing a broken line of showers and isolated thunderstorms to the west this morning. Showers may move across the Louisville area around 9am. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies and hot temperatures can be expected before the chance for scattered thunderstorms develops this afternoon. Thunderstorms will become likely this evening ahead of an approaching cold front. A few storms could be severe with damaging winds, hail and heavy rainfall.
