Extended forecast – Moisture gradually returns Friday making for more humid conditions late in the day. Only a slight chance of thunderstorms is expected during the afternoon with most areas remaining dry. Thunderstorm chances will increase Saturday and especially on Sunday as a cold front approaches the from the northwest. Scattered thunderstorms will be possible Saturday afternoon with showers and thunderstorms becoming likely Sunday as the front moves into the area. Thunderstorms will be capable of producing heavy rainfall and gusty winds.
