MEDICAL EXTENSION SUMMARY

If a player earns the points required to reach the top 125 threshold, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical category. If a player earns the points required to reach the top 150 threshold, but falls short of top 125, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the 126-150 category, subject to reshuffle. If he does not reach either of these thresholds, he will fall back into the highest category for which he is eligible, or lose status.

Medical Extension storylines

Ben Martin is making his final start on his Major Medical Extension and needs 154.217 FedExCup points (2-way T3 or better) to remain in the Major Medical category for the remainder of the season. If Martin fails to earn 154.217 points or more, he will maintain status through the 126-150 category and be subject to conditional category reshuffle.

Will Gordon made the cut on the number at the Rocket Classic in his final start on his Major Medical Extension to maintain status on the PGA TOUR. He fell short of the 2-way T3 required to remain in the Major Medical category but reached his top 150 points, so he moves to No. 3 in the reorder category and is in the field at the John Deere Classic.

TOP 50 RETENTION TRACKING

29 of the top 50 players in the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the top 50 of the current season's standings through the Rocket Classic. At No. 6, Ben Griffin is the highest in the FedExCup standings among players that were outside the top 50 in 2024 (No. 57 in 2024).

For reference:

- » Through the 2024 Rocket Classic, 34 of the top 50 players in the 2023 FedExCup standings were in the top 50 of the FedExCup standings.
- » 31 of the top 50 players in the 2023 FedExCup standings finished the 2024 season in the top 50 of the FedExCup standings.
