Weather: Mostly sunny. High of 93. SSW wind 6-12 mph.

Cut: 64 professionals and one amateur at 5-under 137 from a field of 153 professionals and three amateurs. **Note**: Due to potential thunderstorms Saturday afternoon, the third round will feature threesomes off split tees from approx. 7:45 – 10 a.m. CT.

Doug Ghim (1st/-12)

- 130 marks his lowest opening 36-hole score on TOUR (previous best: 131/2025 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- Holds first 36-hole lead on TOUR (previous best 36-hole position: T2/2022 Genesis Scottish Open)
- Opened first round with a bogey-free 9-under 62, his career-low in 488 rounds (previous: 63/four times)
- Best finish in 162 starts on TOUR: 2nd/2024 Shriners Children's Open
- Illinois native is making his sixth start at the John Deere Classic (best: T18/2021)
- Best finish in 17 starts this season: T11/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches
- Enters the week at No. 124 in the FedExCup standings

Additional notes:

- Defending champion **Davis Thompson** (T2/-11) cards his second career bogey-free round on TOUR this season (2025 The American Express/R3); Seeks to become the first repeat winner at the John Deere Classic since Steve Stricker won three in a row from 2009-11
- Six-time PGA TOUR winner **Max Homa** (T2/-11) records his best 36-hole start this season (previous: 134/Truist Championship); Seeks his first top-10 result this year and best in 16 starts this season: T12/Masters Tournament
- **Brian Campbell** (T2/-11) holds T2 position after 36 holes for the second time in his career (previous: 2025 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld, where he went on to secure his first PGA TOUR victory)
- In search of his first TOUR victory, **David Lipsky** (T2/-11) ties his career low 36-hole score: 131/2023 Sony Open in Hawaii
- Argentinian **Emiliano Grillo** (T2/-11) cards a second-round 5-under 66; Looks to become first international winner of the John Deere Classic since Sepp Straka (2023/Austria)
- Winner of last week's Rocket Classic, PGA TOUR rookie Aldrich Potgieter (T13/-9) cards 5-under 66
 - Last to earn first two wins in consecutive starts was Camilo Villegas (2008 BMW Championship, 2008 TOUR Championship)
 - Last rookie to win twice in a season was Nick Dunlap in 2024 (The American Express, Barracuda Championship)
- The top-three players in the World Amateur Golf Ranking in the field playing on sponsor exemptions: No. 1 Jackson Koivun (T16/-8), No. 2 Ben James (MC), No. 3 Michael La Sasso (MC)
- Nicholas Lindheim withdrew (back injury) prior to his second round; Andrew Putnam withdrew (back injury) during his second round
