Davis Thompson (1st/-15)

- Seeks second PGA TOUR title in his 90th start (2024 John Deere Classic); age on Sunday: 26 years, 1 month, 1 day
- Would become the first winner since K.H. Lee (THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson in 2021 and 2022) to earn first two wins at the same event (back-to-back)
- Would become the second player to successfully defend a title on TOUR this season (Scottie Scheffler/the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday)
- Would become the first repeat winner at the John Deere Classic since Steve Stricker won three in a row from 2009-11
- Holds third 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2023 American Express/2nd, 2024 John Deere Classic/Won)
- Owns one top-10 in 19 starts this season (T10/THE PLAYERS Championship)
- Enters the week at No. 70 in the FedExCup standings with five weeks remaining until the FedExCup Playoffs

Max Homa (T2/-14)

- Seeks seventh PGA TOUR title in his 215th start; age on Sunday: 34 years, 7 months, 17 days
- PGA TOUR wins victories (6): 2019 Truist Championship, 2021 The Genesis Invitational, 2021 Procore Championship, 2022 Truist Championship, 2022 Procore Championship, 2023 Farmers Insurance Open
- Five of his six victories have come when trailing through three rounds:

- Making third start at the John Deere Classic and first since 2017 (T35/2015, MC/2017)
- Seeks his first top-10 result this year; best in 16 starts this season: T12/Masters Tournament
- Enters the week No. 122 in the FedExCup standings

Additional notes:

- **David Lipsky** (T2/-14) seeks first career PGA TOUR title in his 129th start; would become the 10th first-time winner on TOUR this season and the 25th player to make the John Deere Classic his first PGA TOUR victory
- Emiliano Grillo (T2/-14) seeks to become the first Argentinian winner of the John Deere Classic and first international winner of the event since 2023 (Sepp Straka/Austria)
- With a win, **Brian Campbell** (T2/-14) would become the sixth multiple winner on TOUR this season (2025 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld)

- Colombia's **Camilo Villegas** (T6/-12) seeks his sixth PGA TOUR title and first since the 2023 Butterfield Bermuda Championship; with a win on Sunday (age: 43 years, 5 months, 30 days), would become the oldest winner on TOUR this season (Keegan Bradley/Travelers Championship/39 years, 15 days)
- Player on a sponsor exemption, the No. 1-ranked player in the World Amateur Golf Ranking Jackson Koivun (T10/-11) is making his sixth start on the PGA TOUR (best: T48/2025 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard); best finish by an amateur at the John Deere Classic: T2/Luke Clanton/2024
