Otherwise, mostly sunny skies and hot temperatures can be expected this afternoon with highs in the low 90s. The heat index will make it feel more like 95F-97F.

Extended forecast – Hot and humid conditions will Saturday with highs around 90F. The front will slowly move through the state Sunday keeping the chance for showers and a few thunderstorms in the forecast into the early afternoon before drier conditions return for the rest of the day.
