Today – Mostly sunny skies will become partly cloudy later this morning helping temperatures warm to around 90F this afternoon. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop between 3pm-5pm around the area before thunderstorms become likely between 6pm-8pm. There will likely be a lull in the precipitation after 8pm before another round of thunderstorms moves through the area towards midnight. A few storms could be severe with strong, gusty wind and torrential downpours. **Sunrise: 5:32am / Sunset: 8:37pm** Rainfall: 0.25"-0.50" with locally higher amounts likely.
