Brian Campbell (P1/-20)

- Wins first PGA TOUR title in his 28th start at the age of 31 years, 11 months and 17 days
- Earns 500 FedExCup points, moves to No. 12 in the FedExCup standings and is fully exempt through the 2027 PGA TOUR season; also earns spots in all five remaining Signature Events this season, plus THE PLAYERS Championship, Masters Tournament, PGA Championship and 2026 Sentry 2026
- Recorded a final-round 70 including four birdies against three bogeys
- Sets career-low 72-hole score (264) and 54-hole score (194)
- Wins in his tournament debut and third start this season (best: T51/The American Express)
- Joins Jake Knapp (2024) as first-time winners of the event
- Joins Thomas Detry as the second first-time winner on TOUR this season (WM Phoenix Open)
- Previous best finish on TOUR: T12/2017 John Deere Classic
- Finished No. 7 on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List earning 2025 PGA TOUR membership, graduated from the Korn Ferry Tour for the first time in 2016

Miscellaneous notes

- 54-hole leader and PGA TOUR rookie **Aldrich Potgieter** (P2/-20) earns career-best finish in his 10th start on TOUR (previous: T15/2025 Farmers Insurance Open); moves from No. 111 to 29th in the FedExCup standings
- California native Isaiah Salinda (3rd/-19) cards final-round 65 and records career-best result in his 15th start on TOUR (previous best: T42/2025 Farmers Insurance Open); earned 2025 PGA TOUR membership after finishing No. 18 in the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List; winner of the 2024 Panama Championship
- In his fourth appearance at the Mexico Open at VidantaWorld **Aaron Rai** (T4/-18) opened the final-round with three consecutive birdies and an eagle on the par-5 6th en route to his 12th career top-10 in his 97th start on TOUR

- 2025 Latin America Amateur Championship winner **Justin Hastings** (T13/-13), a native of the Cayman Islands who is currently a senior at San Diego State, records best finish by an amateur on TOUR this season (previous: Luke Clanton/T15/Farmers Insurance Open) in his second TOUR start (MC/2024 Puerto Rico Open)
- Defending champion **Jake Knapp** finishes T25 (-11) in first title defense
- Of the five players from Mexico in the field, Santiago de la Fuente (T65/-3) was the only player to make the cut
