Carson Young (1st/-13)

- Second 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2024 World Wide Technology Championship/finished T2)
- Records low round of the day with a bogey-free 64, his lowest round of the season
- In 12 starts this season, has five made cuts and one top-25 finish (T10/Puerto Rico Open)
- Finished T32 in the 2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Championship
- Entered the week No. 153 in the FedExCup standings; projected to move to No. 65 with a win
- Third season on the PGA TOUR, has six top-10 finishes in 78 career starts (best: T2/2024 World Wide Technology Championship)
- Last year, finished No. 88 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings after recording three top-10s in 30 starts
- One career PGA TOUR-sanctioned victory: 2022 Panama Championship (Korn Ferry Tour)
- Native of Anderson, South Carolina and Clemson University alum

Harry Higgs (2nd/-12)

- First time sitting inside the top 10 entering the final round this season in his 13th start of the year
- Bidding for first PGA TOUR victory; best finish in 133 career TOUR starts is solo-second (two times: 2019 Butterfield Bermuda Championship, 2020 Procore Championship)
- Best 54-hole position on TOUR since the 2023 RBC Canadian Open (T2/finished T12)
- Carded a third-round 68, including birdies on three of his final four holes
- Played primarily on the Korn Ferry Tour last year, finishing No. 8 on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List after recording two wins (AdventHealth Championship, Visit Knoxville Open)
- Owns four PGA TOUR-sanctioned wins, three on the Korn Ferry Tour and one PGA TOUR Latinoamérica

Miscellaneous Notes

- Mackenzie Hughes (3rd/-11), who held the solo 18-hole lead and a share of the 36-hole lead, records a 1-under 70; bidding for third PGA TOUR victory (2016 RSM Classic, 2022 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- France's **Victor Perez** (T4/-10) seeks first win in 64th start and owns a pair of third-place finishes (most recent: 3rd/2024 RBC Canadian Open)
- Making his second start at the event (T4/2024), Ryan Fox (T4/-10) records nine birdies, six bogeys and three pars
 en route to 3-under 68; seeks to become the ninth winner from New Zealand and first since Danny Lee (2015
 Greenbrier Classic)
- In his third career PGA TOUR start, sponsor exemption **Davis Shore** (T4/-10) enters the final round three shots off the lead; owns two top-10 finishes in 10 starts on the Korn Ferry Tour this season

- Second-year member **Norman Xiong** (T3/-9) sits inside the top 10 entering the final round for the fourth time of his career and second time this season (T5/Puerto Rico Open/finished T12); in 33 career starts on TOUR, owns one top-10 finish (9th/2024 Puerto Rico Open); two-time winner on the Korn Ferry Tour bidding for first PGA TOUR title
- Rookie **Danny Walker** (T3/-9) enters the final round inside the top 10 for the second time this season and first since THE PLAYERS Championship (T8/finished T6)
- 36-hole co-leader **Cristobal Del Solar** (-5) falls to T31 after a third-round 76
- Defending champion Chris Gotterup (T31/-5) cards a third-round 71 and sits eight shots off the lead
