Playoff

- Ryan Fox defeated Mackenzie Hughes and Harry Higgs with a birdie-3 on the first playoff hole (No. 18)
- First playoff in ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic history
- Marks sixth playoff on TOUR this season and first since RBC Heritage (Justin Thomas defeated Andrew Novak)
- Playoff records:
 - Ryan Fox: 1-0
 - Harry Higgs: 0-1
 - Mackenzie Hughes: 2-1

Ryan Fox (Winner/-15)

- Earns his first PGA TOUR title in his 68th start at the age of 38 years, 3 months, 20 days
- Earns 300 FedExCup points and moves from No. 138 to No. 62 in the FedExCup standings
- Becomes the ninth winner from New Zealand and first since Danny Lee (2015 Greenbrier Classic)
- Eighth first-time winner on TOUR this season and first since Andrew Novak and Ben Griffin (Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- Oldest winner on TOUR since Patton Kizzire (2024 Procore Championship/38 years, 6 months, 12 days)
- Previous-best finishes on TOUR: T4/ Zurich Classic of New Orleans, T4/2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic
- 24 birdies for week ties Harry Higgs for most in the field
- Win marks his second top-five finish at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic (T4/2024, Won/2025)
- Records first top-10 finish in 11 starts this season
- Qualifies for next week's PGA Championship, will be his 23rd major championship appearance

Miscellaneous Notes

- 18-hole leader and two-time PGA TOUR winner **Mackenzie Hughes** (P2/-15) records fifth runner-up of his career in ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic debut
- In his first playoff appearance on TOUR, **Harry Higgs** (P2/-15) earns third runner-up finish in his 134th start (2019 Butterfield Bermuda Championship, 2020 Procore Championship)
- The ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic marked the first of two events where players can qualify for the next Signature Event, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, via the Aon Swing 5. The five players (not exempt via the Aon Next 10 or a higher category) who earn the most FedExCup points in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic and the Charles Schwab Challenge, will qualify for the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday.
