**Extended forecast** – Moisture and instability surge back northward tonight into Sunday morning with an increasing threat for rain across coastal areas of South Carolina. Embedded T-storms and pockets of heavy rain will be possible. Rainfall amounts could approach 1.00" but there will likely be substantial variability in amounts around the area. The rain threat should decrease by Sunday afternoon with drier conditions possible. Additional periods of rain and storms are possible on Monday.
