Extended forecast – A cluster of showers/T-storms that forms over the Upstate South Carolina could push towards coastal areas tonight. The shower/T-storm threat likely diminishes by sunrise Friday, however additional activity could redevelop Friday afternoon/evening. For this upcoming weekend, the Saturday forecast has trended drier, thus rain chances and amounts have been lowered. A higher threat for rain is still expected on Sunday, however potential rainfall amounts remain uncertain.
