Today – Increasing cloud cover is expected with a low (20-25%) threat for rain showers this afternoon. Rainfall amounts would be light, if any rain occurs at all. Temperatures will climb into the middle 70s with a southerly wind developing by midday. Some gusts over 15 mph are possible.

Extended forecast – A low (20-30%) threat for showers exists tonight into Thursday. Lightning could occur in the most organized activity on Thursday. A more substantial threat for showers/T-storms is expected to materialize Thursday night into Friday. Despite the rain chances, the majority of the Thursday/Friday period should feature dry conditions. For this upcoming weekend, confidence in rainfall potential remains low as model guidance shows several various outcomes. Given this uncertainty, the forecast will maintain a 30-40% chance for rain Saturday/Sunday.
