Today – High and mid-level clouds will stream over the region today making for partly sunny to mostly cloudy skies at times. It will be hot and humid with temperatures warming to around 90F/32C this afternoon. A thunderstorm complex is forecast to move out of Tennessee and across the northern half of the state during the late afternoon hours. This will have to be watched, but current thinking is these storms will stay north of Charlotte keeping the tournament dry.

Extended forecast – A cold front is forecast to move through North Carolina Saturday. Another thunderstorm complex ahead of the front will move out of the mountains to our west and weaken as it approaches the Charlotte area early tomorrow morning. There may be a few showers or an isolated thunderstorm between 6am-8am if it holds together. Otherwise, drier air will overspread the area during the afternoon making for less humid conditions with partly cloudy skies. The front will stall south of the region Sunday with slightly cooler temperatures and highs in the mid-80s.
