**Today** – A thunderstorm complex over Alabama will dissipate as it moves eastward this morning. This will spread high and mid-level clouds over the area midday into the early afternoon making for mostly cloudy skies. This will likely increase the wind to 10-15 with a few gusts to 20 mph for several hours before decreasing towards evening. Otherwise, any slight shower chance will stay south of Charlotte today with highs warming into the mid-80s.
