#### Things to Know

- Upon conclusion of Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry which will see
  the field play two 18-hole rounds at both Dye's Valley Course at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass
  Country Club the top five finishers will earn PGA TOUR membership for 2026.
- In the event of a tie for the fifth and final qualifier earning PGA TOUR membership, a hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted to determine the final spot(s) which is a new procedure for PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry, as the top five and ties at Final Stage were previously awarded TOUR membership in 2023 and 2024.
- In addition to awarding PGA TOUR cards, PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry determines 2025 season eligibility for the Korn Ferry Tour and PGA TOUR Americas, with the following performance benefits available at Final Stage:
  - o **Top Five Finishers:** PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season
  - o Next 40 Finishers and Ties: Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2026 season
    - The first 25 finishers and ties in this category will be subject to the third reshuffle (occurs after 14th event), while any remaining finishers within the category will be subject to the second reshuffle (occurs after 10th event)

 All Remaining Finishers: Conditional membership for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season and subject to the reshuffle (first reshuffle occurs after sixth event); membership on PGA TOUR Americas for the 2026 season and subject to the reshuffle (first reshuffle occurs after sixth event)

## Field Notes (as of December 8, 2025)

- The top five players from the 2025 PGA TOUR University Eligibility Ranking earned exemptions to Final Stage, though No. 1 David Ford is not in the field. Additionally, three of the top five players Brendan Valdes, Ian Gilligan, Phichasksn Maichon already earned full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season by virtue of finishing in the top five of the 2025 PGA TOUR University Total Points List (combined FedExCup and Korn Ferry Tour points earned).
  - No. 2 Brendan Valdes (Auburn University)
  - No. 3 Ian Gilligan (University of Florida)
  - No. 4 Jackson Van Paris (Vanderbilt University)
  - No. 5 Phichasksn Maichon (Texas A&M University)

Three additional players from the top 25 of the 2025 PGA TOUR University Ranking qualified for Final Stage, including **Carson Bacha**, who finished No. 10 on the 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Points List and earned full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season.

- Youngest player in the field is Jackson Van Paris, who turned 22 years old in August; he is one of six 22-year-olds in the field. The other five are (from youngest to oldest) Jake Peacock, Luke Gutschewski, Ian Gilligan, Greyson Leach, and Brendan Valdes.
- Field features five players who advanced through each stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry, beginning with Pre-Qualifying.

## **Seeking Status Improvements**

- Numerous Final Stage entrants and qualifiers already earned conditional status for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, or full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season, making Final Stage an opportunity to improve their status.
  - Final Stage entrants who finished Nos. 101-150 in the final 2025 FedExCup Fall standings will have, at minimum, conditional status on TOUR in 2026. Additionally, Nos. 126-150 will have full status on the Korn Ferry Tour in 2026.
