Chan Kim (1st/-6) – DV

- Opens with a bogey-free 6-under 64 at Dye's Valley Course, one of four bogey-free rounds Thursday (all at Dye's Valley)
- Finished No. 130 in the 2025 FedExCup Fall standings, earning an exemption for Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry, conditional status for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, and full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season
- Previously finished No. 112 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings in his first season on TOUR
- Earned PGA TOUR membership for the first time with a No. 2 finish on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List off the strength of back-to-back victories at the Magnit Championship and Albertsons Boise Open presented by Chevron
- Primarily played on the Japan Golf Tour from 2015 through the end of 2022, winning eight times on the circuit and finishing No. 1 on the 2020-21 Order of Merit
- Earned Korn Ferry Tour membership for the first time via a runner-up finish at Final Stage of the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Qualifying Tournament (now PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry)
- Turned professional in 2010 out of Arizona State University, where, in 2008-09, he recorded what was the fifth-lowest single-season scoring average by a freshman in program history (72.20)
- Notable amateur victories include 2007 Hawaii State Amateur, 2008 and 2010 Arizona Stroke Play Championships (both contested on the Champions Course at TPC Scottsdale), and 2009 Pacific Coast Amateur

Additional Player Notes

- **Greyson Sigg** (2nd/-5), who was exempt to Final Stage with a No. 136 finish in the FedExCup Fall standings, cards bogey-free 5-under 65 and sits one stroke off the lead
- **Michael Feagles** (T3/-4) and **A.J. Ewart** (T3/-4) recorded the low rounds of the day at Sawgrass Country Club with matching 4-under 67s
 - Feagles advanced through First and Second Stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry, as he last held membership on a PGA TOUR-sanctioned circuit in 2023, when he finished No. 118 on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List

- Ewart is making his first appearance at Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry after advancing through Second Stage; he was exempt to Second Stage with a No. 15 finish on the 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Points List
- **Yuta Sugiura** (T6/-3), a four-time winner on the Japan Golf Tour, made six birdies against one bogey and one double bogey for a round of 3-under 67; he advanced through both First and Second Stage of PGA Tour Q-School presented by Korn Ferry en route to his first appearance at Final Stage
- **Tyler Wilkes** (T15/-2), who played four seasons at University of Florida (2020-24), leads the five players who advanced through each stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry, beginning at Pre-Qualifying

- *Top Five Finishers:* PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season
- *Next 40 Finishers and Ties:* Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2026 season
 - The first 25 finishers and ties in this category will be subject to the third reshuffle (occurs after 14th event – OccuNet Classic presented by Amarillo National Bank)
 - Any remaining finishers within the category will be subject to the second reshuffle (occurs after 10th event – Colonial Life Charity Classic)
- *All Remaining Finishers:* Conditional membership for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season and subject to the reshuffle (first reshuffle occurs after sixth event – Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank); membership on PGA TOUR Americas for the 2026 season and subject to the reshuffle (first reshuffle occurs after sixth event – Inter Rapidísimo Golf Championship)
