Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Robert MacIntyre claimed his first PGA TOUR career win at the 2024 RBC Canadian Open becoming the eighth first time PGA TOUR winner last season. MacIntyre earned 500 FedExCup Points and finished first in the AON Swing 5 to qualify for the Memorial Tournament and Travelers Championship.
