Matteo Manassero (T1/-14)

- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 50th start; best finish in 49 prior starts on TOUR: T8/2014 Valspar Championship
- Would become ninth first-time winner on TOUR this season and first since Ryan Fox (ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic)
- Would be 18th player to earn his first TOUR title at the RBC Canadian Open and second consecutive Robert MacIntyre (2024)
- 193 marks his lowest 54-hole total on TOUR (previous: 198/2024 Genesis Scottish Open)
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for first time on TOUR (previous best 54-hole position: T7/2014 Open Championship)
- Last Italian player to lead/co-lead thru 54-holes on the PGA TOUR was Francesco Molinari at the 2019 Masters
- Would become the third player (sixth win) from Italy to win on TOUR, joining Francesco Molinari and Toney Penna
- Making his tournament debut at the RBC Canadian Open
- Earned PGA TOUR membership for the 2025 season via a top-10 finish in the 2024 DP World Tour Eligibility Ranking
- Second-year TOUR member; previously earned and accepted Special Temporary Membership in the 2013-14 season
- Five-time DP World Tour winner, most recently at the 2024 Jonsson Workwear Open

Ryan Fox (T1/-14)

- Seeks second PGA TOUR title in his 71st start at the age of 38 years, 4 months, 16 days
- Earned first PGA TOUR victory in a playoff over Mackenzie Hughes and Harry Higgs at ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic
- Would become the fifth multiple winner on TOUR this season (Rory McIlroy/3, Scottie Scheffler/3, Ben Griffin/2, Sepp Straka/2)
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for first time on TOUR (previous best 54-hole position: T2/2024 RBC Canadian Open)
- Is responsible for the last win on TOUR by a player from New Zealand and is oldest winner on TOUR this season
- Seeks second top-10 at the RBC Canadian Open (T7/2024)

Additional Notes

- At T3, 13-under 197, Lee Hodges, Matt McCarty and Kevin Yu each seek their second PGA TOUR victory (Hodges/2023 3M Open, McCarty/2024 Black Desert Championship, Yu/2024 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- Three qualifying spots are available for the 153rd Open at Royal Portrush through the Open Qualifying Series; the leading three finishers, not otherwise exempt, from the RBC Canadian Open will earns spots in the field; through 54 holes the leading non-exempt players are **Lee Hodges**, **Kevin Yu**, **Matt McCarty**
- For the third consecutive year (2023, 2024), eight Canadian players made the cut at the RBC Canadian Open, the most in tournament history since 1983
 - Canadians to make the cut at the RBC Canadian Open: Mackenzie Hughes (T6/-12), Adam Hadwin (T16/-10), Taylor Pendrith (T16/-10), Nick Taylor (T16/-10), Richard Lee (T25/-9), Corey Conners (T29/-8), Ben Silverman (T29/-8), Matthew Anderson (T36/-7)
