Monday Forecast – An approaching cold front will bring a good chance for showers and isolated thunderstorms mid to late morning and continuing into the afternoon. Temperatures will be cooler with highs only reaching 66F/19C due to the rainfall. The system is expected to move east of Southern Ontario by the evening with drier conditions. Rainfall will average 0.30"-0.50" / 8mm-13mm.
