**Today** – Areas of light to moderate rain is streaming northward along a cold front and will continue through mid-morning. The rain will become more scattered during the late morning to midday hours before tapering off during the early to mid-afternoon as the front continues to move slowly to the south and east of Ontario. Breaks in the overcast will allow for some peeks of sunshine as we go through the evening hours.

**Extended forecast** – The front will stall south of the Great Lakes Friday into Saturday with a low-pressure system developing along it. Currently the precipitation associated with this system will stay to the south and east of Toronto with partly to mostly cloudy skies expected. The system will pull away on Sunday with partly cloudy skies and highs around 75F/24C. The next chance for showers will arrive Monday morning as a cold front moves through the region.
