## MEDICAL EXTENSION SUMMARY

If a player earns the points required to reach the top 125 threshold, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical category. If a player earns the points required to reach the top 150 threshold, but falls short of top 125, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the 126-150 category, subject to reshuffle. If he does not reach either of these thresholds, he will fall back into the highest category for which he is eligible, or lose status.

### Medical extension storylines

Bud Cauley is the first player to enter this season on a Medical Extension and play his way into a Signature Event. The field was filled to 72 players using five players (including Cauley) beyond No. 10 in the Aon Next 10 standings.

Cauley has three consecutive top-10s and enters the week No. 36 in the FedExCup standings. He is exempt for the remainder of the season through the Major Medical category after reaching his top 125 points with a T6 at THE PLAYERS Championship.

## TOP 50 RETENTION TRACKING

27 of the top 50 players in the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the top 50 of the current season's standings through the Masters Tournament. At No. 8, J.J. Spaun is the highest in the FedExCup standings among players that were outside the top 50 in 2024 (No. 96 in 2024).

For reference:

- » Through the 2024 Masters Tournament, 33 of the top 50 players in the 2023 FedExCup standings were in the top 50 of the FedExCup standings.
- » 31 of the top 50 players in the 2023 FedExCup standings finished the 2024 season in the top 50 of the FedExCup standings.

## AON SWING 5

The Corales Puntacana Championship is the first of three events counting towards the Aon Swing 5 for the Truist Championship. The five players, not otherwise exempt, earning the most FedExCup points in the Corales Puntacana Championship, Zurich Classic of New Orleans and THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson will qualify for the Truist Championship via the Aon Swing 5.

Although winners of additional events are not guaranteed spots in Signature Events, Billy Horschel (winner) and Kevin Tway (solo-third) qualified for the 2024 Truist Championship through the Aon Swing 5 after high finishes at the Corales Puntacana Championship.
