Justin Thomas (1st/-12)

- After tying the RBC Heritage 18-hole scoring record in the first round, posts 2-under 69 and holds a two-stroke lead
- Holds 14th career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and first since 2022 Farmers Insurance Open (finished T20)
- 6-for-13 converting 36-hole lead/co-lead to victory on TOUR (most recent: 2019 THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES)
- First-round leader seeks to become the first 18-hole leader/co-leader to win on TOUR this season
- Making his 250th start on the PGA TOUR and 59th since most recent victory (2022 PGA Championship)
- Has the most TOUR wins (15) and is one of seven past FedExCup Champions (2017) in the field
- Two top-10s in six starts at the RBC Heritage (T8/2020, T5/2024)
- Making his 10th start of the season, with runner-up finishes at The American Express and Valspar Championship
- Enters the week No. 11 in the FedExCup and No. 8 in the Official World Golf Ranking

Miscellaneous Notes

- With 7-under 64, **Si Woo Kim** (T2/-10) records his career-low score in 28 rounds at the RBC Heritage (previous: 65/R2/2018) and his lowest round on TOUR since the 2024 Baycurrent Classic (64/R4); marks his 25th career round of 7-under or better in his 880th career stroke-play round
- 2025 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard champion **Russell Henley** (T2/-10) cards 3-under 68 in the second round, his ninth straight under-par round at the event; seeks to become the second multiple winner on TOUR this season (Rory McIlroy: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, THE PLAYERS Championship, Masters Tournament)
- England's **Tommy Fleetwood** (T4/-9) seeks first PGA TOUR win in 153rd start and owns five runner-up finishes on TOUR (most recent: P2/2023 RBC Canadian Open); would become the 15th first-time winner of the event and first since C.T. Pan in 2019
- World No. 1 and defending champion **Scottie Scheffler** (T6) sits four shots back after 36 holes; seeks third successful title defense on TOUR (2023 WM Phoenix Open, 2024 PLAYERS Championship) and to become the first player to successfully defend a title at the RBC Heritage since Boo Weekley in 2008
