Kevin Roy (T1/-10)

- Sets new 18-hole tournament scoring record with a 10-under 62 (previous: 63, 10 times, most recently by Min Woo Lee/R1/2025)
- Matches career-low 18-hole score on TOUR (R1/2025 Puerto Rico Open)
- Holds 18-hole lead/co-lead for the second time of his career on TOUR (2025 Puerto Rico Open/T6)
- Making second career start in the Rocket Classic (MC/2023)
- In 16 starts this season, owns five top-25 finishes and one top-10 (T6/Puerto Rico Open)
- Entered the week No. 100 in the FedExCup standings
- Last year on the Korn Ferry Tour, logged two runner-up finishes and five top-10s, finishing No. 13 on the points list and securing a return to the PGA TOUR

Aldrich Potgieter (T1/-10)

- Matches Roy's 10-under 62 to claim a share of the first-round lead and 18-hole tournament scoring record
- Records a 7-under 29 on his first nine holes (Nos. 10-18), becoming the first player to card a sub-30 score on the back nine at Detroit Golf Club; lowest nine-hole score in tournament history is 28 (Cameron Champ/2019/R2/front nine)
- Marks his first career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR
- Second-lowest 18-hole score of his TOUR career (61/R2/2025 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld)
- PGA TOUR rookie owns three top-25 finishes in 13 starts this season (T15/Farmers Insurance Open, P2/Mexico Open at VidantaWorld, T6/Charles Schwab Challenge)
- Youngest 2025 PGA TOUR member (20 years, 9 months, 13 days) and bidding to become the second rookie to win on TOUR this season (Karl Vilips/Puerto Rico Open)
- Leads all players in Driving Distance this season (326.6)

Additional notes:

- Opening with a 9-under 63, Min Woo Lee (T3/-9) ties his career-low 18-hole score on TOUR (63/R3/2025 Texas Children's Houston Open/Won) and set a new career-low score relative to par (previous: 7-under, two times, R1/2024 American Express and R3/2025 Texas Children's Houston Open); making his second career start in the Rocket Classic (T2/2024); on the 72nd hole of regulation last year, bogeyed the par-4 18th and settled for runner-up, one shot back from winner Cam Davis
- Mark Hubbard (T3/-9) cards a bogey-free 63, his lowest score in 15 career rounds played at Detroit Golf Club; owns one top-25 finish in five prior starts in the Rocket Classic (T12/2020); ties his career low 18-hole score on TOUR (R1/2021 WM Phoenix Open and R2/2021 Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- Max Greyserman (T3/-9) birdies five of his final seven holes en route to a 63, tying his lowest 18-hole score of the season (The Sentry/R3); marks his best 18-hole position since the 2024 Baycurrent Classic (T2/finished T2)
- 2023 Rocket Classic champion Rickie Fowler sits T108 following a 1-under 71

- Defending champion **Cam Davis** (T149/+2) opens with a 74; only two-time winner in tournament history, has finished inside the top-25 in each of his last four starts in the event (Won/2024, T17/2023, T14/2022, Won/2021)
- 25 players recorded bogey-free rounds, the most in a single round this season (previous: 23/R1/The American Express)
- 129 players were under-par in the first round, the most in a single round this season (previous: 118/R2/The American Express)
