

**Extended forecast** – The weather pattern will remain active from Wednesday through Friday as a stalled frontal boundary sits across southern Michigan. The main storm track will set up along this stalled front with a series of thunderstorm clusters tracking across the state this week. High pressure looks to briefly set up across the state on Saturday with the next weather system possibly arriving late Sunday into Sunday night. Wednesday will be the coolest day this week with temperatures in the 70s, then expect high temperatures in the 80s during tournament rounds.
