• Saturday's final pairing will feature players with South African ties; **Garrick Higgo** was born in Johannesburg, while **Eric Cole's** father, Bobby Cole, is a native of South Africa and winner of the 1977 Buick Open on the PGA TOUR

Garrick Higgo (1st/-13)

- 131 ties his career-low 36-hole total on TOUR (2023 John Deere Classic/T21, 2024 ISCO Championship/63rd)
- Holds his first 36-hole lead/co-lead; previous-best second-round position: T2, most recently en route to winning the 2025
 Corales Puntacana Championship
- Two-time PGA TOUR winner claimed first TOUR title at the 2021 Palmetto Championship at Congaree in his second-ever start; also owns three DP World Tour victories and two Sunshine Tour wins in his native South Africa
- One of three lefthanders to win this season (Joe Highsmith/The Cognizant Classic, Brian Harman/Valero Texas Open)
- Attempting to become the second lefthander to win at the Country Club of Jackson (Cody Gribble/2016)
- Made 97 feet, 11 inches of putts in round two after making 98 feet, 3 inches of putts in round one (4-inch difference)
- Making his fourth start at the event (3rd/2022, T16/2023, MC/2024)
- No. 88 in the FedExCup Fall standings with two top-10 finishes in 12 starts (1st/Corales Puntacana Championship, T7/Procore Championship)
- Began this season while playing out of the 126-150 category in 2024 FedExCup Fall standings and made four Korn Ferry Tour starts and two PGA TOUR starts before winning the 2025 Corales Puntacana Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- First-round co-leader Eric Cole (T2/-12) cards 17 birdies through 36 holes, the most by any player in the field
- Taylor Montgomery (T2/-12) posts career-best seven consecutive birdies (Nos. 15 thru 3) en route to a 9-under 63 to tie the most consecutive birdies this season (Adam Hadwin/WM Phoenix Open, Sepp Straka/The Sentry); marks the most consecutive birdies at the Country Club of Jackson; 10 total birdies marks his most in a single round on TOUR
- One day shy of his 30th birthday, **Danny Walker** (4th/-11) makes his first cut since the 2025 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic (T34) in May; missed eight consecutive cuts heading into this week
- **Kevin Streelman** (T16/-7) is the only player bogey-free through 36 holes; making his second start since the 2025 WM Phoenix Open in February after undergoing surgery for a torn meniscus (T57/Procore Championship)
- Sponsor exemption and Walnut, Mississippi native **Kye Meeks** (T28/-6) makes the cut in his PGA TOUR debut; has made three cuts in nine starts on PGA TOUR Americas
- Monday qualifier **Doc Redman** (T56/-4) cards 7-under 65 following a first-round 75 to make the cut on the number in his first start on TOUR since the 2023 RSM Classic
