Garrick Higgo (1st/-18)

- Holds his first 54-hole lead/co-lead; previous-best third-round position in an individual stroke-play event: T2 (2025 Corales Puntacana Championship/won after trailing Joel Dahmen by three strokes)
- 198 marks his career-low 54-hole total on TOUR (previous-best: 202 three occasions, most recently en route to winning the 2025 Corales Puntacana Championship)
- Seeking to become the seventh multiple winner of the season
- Two-time PGA TOUR winner claimed first TOUR title at the 2021 Palmetto Championship at Congaree in his second-ever start; also owns three DP World Tour victories and two Sunshine Tour wins in his native South Africa
- Has two top-10 finishes in 12 starts this season (1st/Corales Puntacana Championship, T7/Procore Championship)
- One of three lefthanders to win this season (Joe Highsmith/The Cognizant Classic, Brian Harman/Valero Texas Open)
- Attempting to become the second lefthander to win at the Country Club of Jackson (Cody Gribble/2016)
- Making his fourth start at the event (3rd/2022, T16/2023, MC/2024)
- Currently projected No. 51 in the FedExCup Fall standings after entering the week No. 88; Nos. 51-60 in the final FedExCup
 Fall standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will serve as the Aon Next 10 and gain entry into the AT&T Pebble Beach
 Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Began this season while playing out of the 126-150 category in 2024 FedExCup Fall standings and made four Korn Ferry Tour starts and two PGA TOUR starts before winning the 2025 Corales Puntacana Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- On his 30th birthday, PGA TOUR Rookie **Danny Walker** (T2/-16) birdies the last five holes for a 5-under 67, marking his career-best birdie streak (previous-best was three in a row, most recently during the second round of the 2025 3M Open); has the most feet of putts made (451'4") through three rounds in the Shotlink era; currently projected No. 72 after entering the week No. 104 in the FedExCup Fall standings; has one top-10 finish in 21 starts (T6/THE PLAYERS Championship)
- Steven Fisk (T2/-16) and Taylor Montgomery (4th/-15) are seeking their first victory in their 24th and 76th start, respectively; either would become the 15th player to earn his first TOUR title at the event (most recent: Kevin Yu/2024); Fisk's best finish is T4 at the 2025 Puerto Rico Open and Montgomery's is third at the 2022 Procore Championship
- A victory Sunday for **Matt Kuchar** (T5/-14) would come at the age of 47 years, 3 months, 14 days and make him the oldest winner on TOUR since Phil Mickelson won the 2021 PGA Championship at the age of 50 years, 11 months, 7 days
- Max Homa (T8/-13) trails by five following the round of the day, an 8-under 64; five of his six PGA TOUR victories have been in come-from-behind fashion, including his last five wins (most recent: 2023 Farmers Insurance Open):
