



# 2025 Sanderson Farms Championship (Second of seven FedExCup Fall events)

#### Steven Fisk (Won/-24)

- Wins first PGA TOUR title in his 24<sup>th</sup> start at 28 years, 5 months, 18 days
- 264 total is one stroke shy of the 72-hole tournament record (263/Dan Halldorson/1986)
- 24-under ties the lowest winning score in relation to par at this event (Scott Stallings/2012)
- At 24-under 264, sets the Sanderson Farms Championship scoring record since the event moved to the Country Club of Jackson (previous: 265/Kevin Yu/2024)
- Betters his previous best 72-hole total on TOUR in an individual stroke-play event: 269/2025 Puerto Rico Open/T4
- Making his Sanderson Farms Championship debut, becomes the 15<sup>th</sup> first-time PGA TOUR winner at this event and second consecutive (Kevin Yu)
- Becomes 14<sup>th</sup> first-time winner this season (most recent: Tommy Fleetwood/TOUR Championship)
- Becomes fourth PGA TOUR rookie to win this season, joining Karl Villips (Puerto Rico Open), Aldrich Potgieter (Rocket Classic) and William Mouw (ISCO Championship)
- Moves from No. 135 to No. 65 in the FedExCup Fall standings
- Previous best finish on TOUR: T4/2025 Puerto Rico Open
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (11.912)
- Nine birdies in the final round marks his most in a single round on TOUR
- Former Georgia Southern University golfer won the 2024 Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club on the Korn Ferry Tour in a playoff, approximately a one-hour drive from where he attended college
- Finished No. 4 on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List to earn PGA TOUR status for 2025
- Member of the winning 2019 U.S. Walker Cup team at Royal Liverpool Golf Club

#### **Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Garrick Higgo** (2<sup>nd</sup>/-22) was seeking his second victory this season (Corales Puntacana Championship) and attempting to become the second lefthander to win at the Country Club of Jackson (Cody Gribble); moves to No. 62 in the FedExCup Fall standings after entering the week at No. 88
- Rasmus Højgaard (T3/-19), a member of last week's winning European Team at the Ryder Cup, posts his best result in a standard stroke-play event in 41 starts on TOUR; lone top-10 finish in 18 prior starts this season came with twin brother/playing partner, Nicolai, at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (2<sup>nd</sup>)
- Vince Whaley (T3/-19) cards his best finish in the Sanderson Farms Championship; made the cut in all seven appearances at this event
- Requiring 107 feet, 8 inches of putts in the final round to surpass Kevin Na's TOUR record (558' 11"/2019 Shriners
  Children's Open), PGA TOUR Rookie Danny Walker (T3/-19) makes 64' 6" of putts to fall short of the record; 515' 10" total
  surpasses Adam Long's 500' 3" total made in 2022 as the most at the Country Club of Jackson; T3 marks his best finish on
  TOUR; moves to No. 86 after entering the week No. 104 in the FedExCup Fall standings
- **Taylor Montgomery** (T6/-17) had 94 putts, the only player in the field with fewer than 100 putts, and the fewest putts by any player in a single tournament this season

- After making the 36-hole cut on the number, Monday qualifier **Doc Redman** (T9/-16) earns a spot in the 2025 Bank of Utah Championship with his top-10 finish
- **Kevin Yu** (T11/-15) posts four rounds under par while attempting to become the first back-to-back winner at the Sanderson Farms Championship

## FedExCup Fall Notes

- The 2025 Sanderson Farms Championship is the second event of the FedExCup Fall, a group of seven tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season.
- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2026 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)
  - Zero players moved in or fell out of Nos. 51-60
- The Top 100 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 101-150 will have conditional status on TOUR
  - O Players to move into the Top 100: **Steven Fisk** (1<sup>st</sup>; from No. 135 to No. 65), **Vince Whaley** (T3; from No. 102 to No. 84), **Danny Walker** (T3; from No. 104 to No. 86), **Max Homa** (T18; from No. 107 to No. 99)
  - o Players to fall out of the Top 100: **Austin Eckroat** (DNP; from No. 96 to No. 101), **Isaiah Salinda** (MC; from No. 97 to No. 102), **Joel Dahmen** (MC; from No. 98 to No. 103), **Lanto Griffin** (MC; from No. 100 to No. 105)
