## 2025 Sony Open in Hawaii ShotLink Broadcast Notes



### Aon Swing 5 & Aon Next 10 Breakdown:

The Sony Open in Hawaii, the second event of the 2025 PGA TOUR Season and first Full-Field Event, is the first opportunity for players to earn FedExCup points towards the Aon Swing 5 with entry into each of the next two Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational).

The top five players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express and Farmers Insurance Open will qualify for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, while the top five players not otherwise exempt who earn the most FedExCup points during those three events and the WM Phoenix Open, will qualify for The Genesis Invitational.

The Aon Next 10 represents the top 10 players not already exempt, from the FedExCup standings, while the Aon Swing 5 includes the top five FedExCup points earners, not already exempt, from a collection of Full-Field Events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings

**Luke Clanton:** will be making his 9<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR start as an amateur, playing eight events in 2024 only missing one cut with three top 5 finishes and four top 10 finishes overall. Clanton made his Major debut as an amateur at the 2024 U.S. Open making the cut finishing T41.
