# SIGNATURE EVENT FACT SHEET (ENTERING THE AMERICAN EXPRESS)

## **OVERVIEW**

Signature Events are limited-field events comprised of the top PGA TOUR players from the previous season's FedExCup as well as trending players from the current season who play their way in via the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5. These eligibility pathways deliver compelling storylines and added consequence at Full Field Events while impacting the season-long race for the FedExCup.

## AON NEXT 10 and AON SWING 5

The Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5 are eligibility pathways for players, not already qualified, to play their way into Signature Events via the FedExCup standings.





- Aon Next 10: Top 10 available players, not otherwise exempt, from FedExCup standings. The Aon Next 10 will always fill to 10 players. (Note: the Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the FedExCup Fall standings. For each Signature Event after, the Aon Next 10 will include the top 10 players from the current FedExCup standings, not otherwise exempt, through the week prior)
- Aon Swing 5: Top five available players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points from events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Swing 5 will always fill to five players.

## **STORYLINES**

The American Express is the second event where players can earn FedExCup points toward the Aon Swing 5 to earn their spot in each of the next two Signature Events: the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational. The top five players not otherwise exempt who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express and Farmers Insurance Open will qualify for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, while the top five players not otherwise exempt who earn the most FedExCup points during those three events and the WM Phoenix Open, will qualify for The Genesis Invitational. The Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the FedExCup Fall standings.

#### LAST WEEK ON TOUR: Sony Open in Hawaii

54-hole leader J.J. Spaun finished T3 to lead the Aon Swing 5 standings and seeks to return to the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am after qualifying via the Aon Next 10 in 2024. Sony Open in Hawaii winner Nick Taylor and runner-up Nico Echavarria are already qualified for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am through the Aon Next 10. Nick Taylor is now exempt for the remaining Signature Events in 2025.

## **PLAYERS TO WATCH: The American Express**

Patrick Fishburn enters The American Express T2 in the Aon Swing 5 standings following his T6 at the Sony Open in Hawaii and is in search of his first start in a Signature Event. Fishburn finished No. 81 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings during his rookie season.

Three rookies are positioned within the top five of the Aon Swing 5 standings following the Sony Open in Hawaii: Jackson Suber (T2), Paul Peterson and Jesper Svensson (T5).

Italy's Matteo Manassero is making his first start as a PGA TOUR member after earning his card through the DP World Tour Top 10. A five-time winner on the DP World Tour, Manassero previously held PGA TOUR Special Temporary Membership as a 21-year-old in 2014.

## SIGNATURE EVENTS ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility criteria for Signature Events (outside The Sentry):

- Top 50 in the previous season's FedExCup standings
- Aon Next 10
- Aon Swing 5
- If not exempt from a higher category listed above: current-vear tournament winners (excluding Additional Events) and PGA TOUR members in the top 30 in the OWGR
- Four sponsor exemptions (PGA TOUR members)
- The three player-hosted events each have one tournament host exemption, which is not restricted to PGA TOUR members

# **QUICK FACTS**

- · Field sizes for Signature Events are approximately 70-80 players (80 players for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am due to format). New in 2025, fields will have a minimum of 72 players. If necessary to fill the field, tournaments will use the next available player(s) from the Aon Next 10.
