Extended forecast – Showers and thunderstorms will be likely Friday as a cold front finally pushes south through North Texas as we go through the day. Storms could be strong with gusty wind and small hail. The front will stall south of the DFW area this weekend keeping the thunderstorm threat across Southern Texas. Cooler and drier air will settle over North Texas Saturday and Sunday with lows in the 50s and highs in the 70s under partly to mostly sunny skies. Dry weather continues Monday before the next system brings the chance for thunderstorms Tuesday into Wednesday.
